

2019/20 TIO NTFL PLAY OF THE ROUND COMPETITION – PRIZES AND TERMS

Prizes

Watch the nominees each round, vote for your favourite play of the round and go into the running for the weekly prize and the major prize.

The AFLNT will also award a prize to the player featured in the winning play of the round.

How it works

Each week's nominated plays of the round are selected by AFLNT footy experts, but the weekly winning play of the round is in your hands.

For your shot at the weekly prize, simply vote for your favourite play of the round. If your play of the round ends up being voted the weekly winner, you're in the running for the weekly prize.

Voting opens 2pm each round on the Monday after the last game, and closes on the Friday before commencement of the next round at 8.59am (except in the case of Round 15 where it will open on Tuesday 28 January).

Please refer to the voting opening and closing times and draw dates listed in the Terms and Conditions below, as exact days of the week may change depending on the fixture for each round.

On 24 February 2020, one lucky entrant who entered the Promotion will win the major prize.

Terms and Conditions of Entry for the "2019/20 TIO NTFL Play of the Round Competition"

ENTRY

1. This document contains the terms and conditions of entry ("these Terms") into the 2019/20 TIO NTFL Play of the Round Competition ("Promotion"). Entry into this Promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms.
2. The Promoter is AFL Northern Territory Limited ("AFL") ABN 81 097 620 525 of 70 Abala Road, Marrara Northern Territory, 0812, Australia ("Promoter").
3. The Promotion will open 2:00pm on Monday, 7 October 2019 and will continue until 8:59am Friday, 21 February 2020 ("Promotion Period"). All times in these Terms are expressed in the local time of Darwin, Northern Territory, Australia.
4. Entry is open to all people excluding employees of the Promoter and other agencies, firms or companies associated with this Promotion, and their immediate families. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin. Persons entering the Promotion who are under 18 years of age require their parent's or legal guardian's permission. Only Entrants who reside in the Northern Territory, Australia will be eligible for prizes.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

5. To register for the Promotion entrants must during the Promotion Period register their details via the on-line registration form located on the 2019/20 TIO NTFL Play of the Round website at <http://playsoftheround.aflnt.com.au> ("Online Entry Site") ("Entrant").
6. The Promoter reserves the right not to accept a registration for any Entrant or to disqualify an Entrant if the Promoter considers that the registration contains anything defamatory or is otherwise inappropriate.
7. An Entrant may only register as an individual.
8. The AFL will be conducting the 2019/20 TIO NTFL Play of the Round Competition ("Competition"). This Promotion will be conducted in conjunction with the Competition. In the Competition, AFL representatives as selected by the Promoter ("AFL Media") will select three (3) plays in the matches played in the relevant 2019/20 TIO NTFL Men's Premier League home and away round ("Competition Round") and announce and publish the plays at the Online Entry Site.
9. Entrants can complete their entry during the Promotion Period by:
 1. logging on to the Online Entry Site and submitting a vote in the Promotion in any one of the eighteen (18) Competition Rounds, and then fully completing the requested details in accordance with the directions on the entry page; and
 2. indicating their acceptance of these Terms ("Qualifying Entry").
10. Voting for each Competition Round will open and close at the times described below.

11. Entrants can vote for the play in each of the eighteen (18) Competition Rounds. By submitting a vote in a Competition Round an Entrant will be eligible to enter the Minor Prize Draw that corresponds to that Competition Round. By submitting a vote in the Promotion before 8.59am on Friday, 21 February 2020 an Entrant will be eligible to enter the Major Prize Draw.
12. Each Entrant may only have one entry in any Minor Prize Draw and the Major Prize Draw.

WEEKLY PRIZE

14. Entrants will receive one (1) entry into the corresponding Minor Prize Draw for the first time they submit a vote in relation to that Competition Round.
15. A random prize draw will be conducted at the AFL Northern Territory Limited, 70 Abala Road, Marrara Northern Territory, 0812, Australia ("Draw Location") from all entries received for the most voted play(s) relating to each Competition Round at 11am on the dates detailed in clause 10 above ("Minor Prize Draws").
16. The first Entrant with a valid Qualifying Entry drawn in each Minor Prize Draw will receive from the Promoter the Weekly Prize. The Weekly Prize consists of two (2) grandstand tickets to the 2020 Toyota AFL Premiership game to be played in Darwin (TBC) and a \$35 food and beverage voucher to be used at TIO Stadium during the game (valued at up to \$110 including GST). TIO Stadium is located at 70 Abala Road, Marrara in the Northern Territory.
17. The total value of the Weekly Prize pool is \$1,980 (including GST) based on one winner per week for 18 Competition Rounds.
18. Each winner will be contacted in writing within two (2) days of the date of being drawn a winner, and their name will be published on the Online Entry Site within seven (7) days of the end of the respective close of voting in the Competition Round.
19. An Entrant who has won a Weekly Prize will be ineligible to win a further Weekly Prize.
20. The Promoter will also award a prize to the player the Promoter deems central to the most voted play(s) relating to each Competition Round ("Player Prize"). The Player Prize is an Intersport voucher to the value of \$100 (valued at up to \$100 including GST). The total value of the Player Prize pool is \$1,800 (including GST) based on one winner per week for 18 Competition Rounds.

MAJOR PRIZE

21. Entrants will receive one (1) entry into the Major Prize Draw for the first time they submit a vote in relation to the Promotion up until 8.59am on 21 February 2020.
22. A random prize draw will be conducted at the Draw Location by the Promoter at 11:00 am on Monday, 24 February 2020 ("Major Prize Draw").
23. The first Entrant with a valid Qualifying Entry drawn in the Major Prize Draw will win the Major Prize. The Major Prize consists of (a) two (2) grandstand tickets to the 2020 Toyota AFL Premiership game to be played in Darwin (TBC) and a \$35 food and beverage voucher to be used at TIO Stadium during the game (valued at up to \$110 including GST); and (b) an Intersport voucher to the value of \$200 (valued at up to \$200 including GST).
24. The Major Prize is valued at up to \$310 (including GST).
25. The Major Prize winner will be contacted in writing within two (2) days of the date of being drawn a winner, and their name will be published on the Online Entry Site on Wednesday, 26 February 2020.

UNCLAIMED PRIZE DRAW

26. In the event that any Weekly Prize or the Major Prize has not been claimed by 16 March 2020 by that winner of the prize, the winner forfeits their prize and the prize may be entered in an Unclaimed Prize Draw that may be conducted at 11am on 17 March 2020 at the Draw Location. Any prize winner(s) will be contacted in writing on the day of the Unclaimed Prize Draw and their name published on Online Entry Site immediately following the Unclaimed Prize Draw.
27. If more than one person attempts to claim a prize, the Promoter has sole and absolute discretion to determine which of those persons is the winning Entrant(s), subject to any direction of a relevant authority.

MINORS

28. If an Entrant is under 18 years, they must have their parent or guardian's consent to enter the Promotion. The Promoter reserves the right to request this consent in writing. If consent in writing is requested, the winner's nominated parent/legal guardian will be required to include the words "in consideration of AFL agreeing to admit the Entrant into this Promotion, [name of Parent or Guardian] agrees to be bound by the terms of entry into the Promotion" in such written consent.
29. If a prize winner is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to the winner's nominated parent or legal guardian on behalf of the winner.
30. Minors may use the prize, but they must have consent from their parent or legal guardian (which the Promoter may request in writing).

GENERAL

31. Each Qualifying Entry counts towards one (1) entry only.
32. Prizes cannot be redeemed for cash and are not transferable or exchangeable and, if applicable, cheques will be not negotiable.
33. Subject to the Unclaimed Prize Draw clause, if for any reason a winner does not take a prize, then the prize will be forfeited.
34. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries, registrations and Entrants (including an Entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify any Entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms or who tampers with the entry/registration/voting process. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
35. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an Entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the Entrant.
36. The total prize pool for this Promotion is valued at \$4,090 (including GST).
37. Incomplete, indecipherable and incorrect entries/registrations or entries/registrations containing offensive or defamatory comments, or which breach any law or infringe any third party rights, including intellectual property rights, are not eligible to win.
38. It is a condition of taking a prize that the winner must, if requested to do so by the Promoter, sign and return documents relating to their eligibility to enter (including ownership of entry), statement of compliance with relevant terms and conditions and/or a release of the Promoter's liability in taking prizes.
39. 40. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any entries or registrations not received for any reason during the Promotion. Registrations and entries will be deemed to be accepted at the time of receipt and not at the time of transmission. No responsibility will be taken for lost, late or misdirected registrations or entries. The Promoter is not responsible for technical difficulties with the entry mechanism and does not warrant that the entry mechanism will be available at all times.
41. If the Promoter is unable to provide a winner with the nominated prize, the Promoter reserves the right to supply an alternative prize of similar monetary value, subject to any written directions given by State gaming departments.
42. Any Entrant who, in the opinion of the Promoter, tampers or interferes with the entry mechanism in any way, or who does not properly comply with the entry process, will be ineligible to win.

43. Entrants consent to the Promoter using their name, likeness, image and/or voice in the event they are a winner (including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this promotion (including any outcome), and promoting any products manufactured, distributed and/or supplied by the Promoter.

45. Information about Entrants is used by the Promoter to assess and process registration in the Promotion. If an Entrant does not provide the required information, the Promoter cannot process the registration. All registrations/entries become the property of the Promoter and will be entered into a database. Information emanating from the Entrant's participation in the Promotion is used by the Promoter and its agencies, contractors and service providers associated with this Promotion for the determination of winners and distribution of prizes, if any, awarded to an Entrant. Entry is conditional on providing this information. Entrants consent to publishing their name in the prize page of the Online Entry Site and for their personal information ("PI") to be disclosed to State and Territory lottery departments, as required under the relevant lottery legislation. The Promoter will not be held responsible for any loss of reputation, status or otherwise in connection with an Entrant's selections and consequential results. The Promoter will also use and handle PI as set out in its Privacy Policy, which can be viewed at www.afl.com.au/privacy. The Privacy Policy also contains information about how Entrants may opt out, access, update or correct their personal information, how Entrants may complain about a breach of the Australian Privacy Principles or any other applicable law and how those complaints will be dealt with.
46. By participating in this Promotion, the Entrant agrees and acknowledges that:
 1. they may be contacted by the Promoter to provide comments about the Promotion and the Competition and the Promoter (or an agent of the Promoter) may take photos of them;
 2. the Promoter may use such comments or photos (the "Materials") for the Promoter's future promotional and marketing purposes without further reference or compensation to them;
 3. the Promoter may duplicate, alter, adapt and utilise the Materials as the Promoter wishes at anytime, anywhere, and by any means. The Promoter may license, authorise or otherwise transfer the rights in the Materials to others to do the same;

 6. they waive all Moral Rights in the Materials that arise outside Australia; and
 7. they agree not to institute, maintain or support any claim or proceeding for infringement of their Moral Rights in the Materials.
47. Any costs associated with entering the Promotion (including but not limited to accessing the Online Entry Site) and/or using a prize is the Entrant's responsibility.
48. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits, excludes or modifies or purports to limit, exclude or modify the statutory consumer guarantees as provided under the Competition and Consumer Act, as well as any

other implied warranties under the ASIC Act or similar consumer protection laws in the States and Territories of Australia ("Non-Excludable Guarantees"). Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the Promotion.

49. Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) is not responsible for and excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference; (c) any entry, registration, tip or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) any tax liability incurred by a winner or Entrant; or (f) taking and/or use of a prize.

53. If a prize includes vouchers, all vouchers are valid until the voucher expiry date as specified on the voucher or by the provider of the voucher. Vouchers are subject to the conditions stipulated by the provider of the voucher. Any such further voucher is valid for the remainder of the original voucher expiry period. Vouchers cannot be redeemed for further vouchers.
54. If a prize includes tickets, all tickets are valid for the date or period as indicated on the tickets. Tickets are subject to the conditions stipulated by the provider of the tickets. No travel and ancillary costs that are not stated form part of a ticket prize unless expressly provided.
